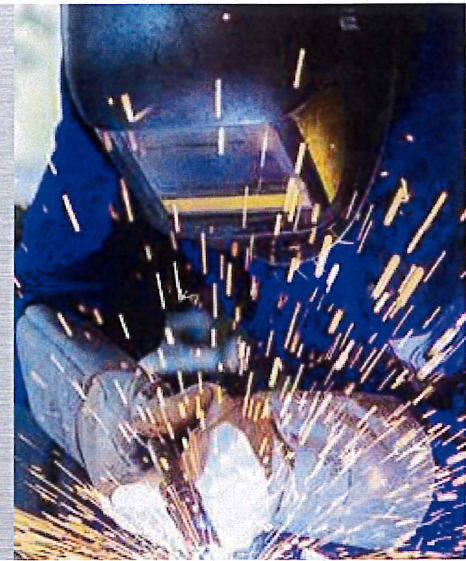


Interested in a Skilled Trade, Apprenticeship or Similar Work-Based Learning Opportunity?

Classes run June 20–August 12, 2016.

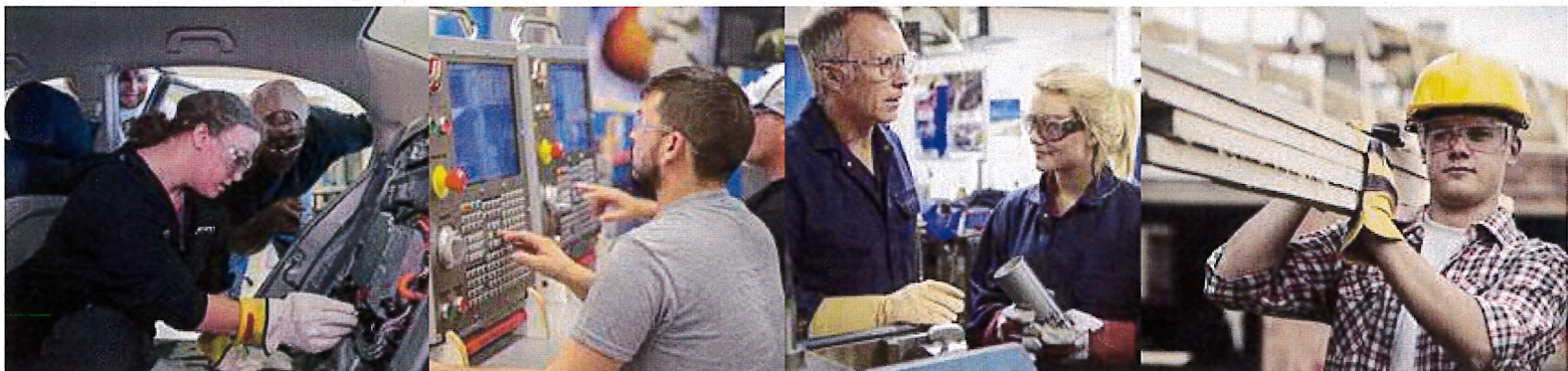
